2025 YOUTH CABINET


The Youth Cabinet at United Way of Amarillo & Canyon is a youth leadership program made up of high school students from Amarillo, Canyon, and Bushland. These student leaders work together to run fundraising campaigns within their schools, raising money to support local programs that make a difference in the Amarillo and Canyon communities. Through this initiative, students gain leadership skills while giving back to their neighbors.

In 2024 they raised \$53,834.59, Youth Cabinet allocated to programs such as Coalition of Health Services, Amarillo CASA, Area Agency on Aging, Wesley Community Center, Maverick Boys & Girls Club of Amarillo, Salvation Army, Boy & Girl Scouts, Gyon Suanders, and Catholic Charities.













The Why and How these Programs

The Allocations Council at United Way of Amarillo & Canyon is a group of dedicated community volunteers who vet, research, and thoughtfully discuss how funding is distributed to local programs. This group is made up entirely of volunteers—not staff or board members—and anyone in the community is welcome to join and have a voice in the decision-making process.






